

U.S. residents who used a credit, debit, or other payment card between February 16, 2016 and July 7, 2016 at some Kimpton hotels and restaurants may be eligible for a payment from a class action settlement.

A Settlement has been reached with Kimpton Hotel & Restaurant Group, LLC (“Kimpton”) in a class action lawsuit about a data security incident that occurred between February 16, 2016 and July 7, 2016, during which Kimpton was the victim of a cyber-attack in which the attackers installed unauthorized malware on certain servers that processed payment cards used at some Kimpton hotels and restaurants (the “Security Incident”). For a list of affected Kimpton hotels and restaurants, go to www.KimptonSettlement.com. This lawsuit was filed asserting claims against Kimpton relating to the Security Incident. Kimpton denies all of the claims and says it did not do anything wrong.

WHO IS INCLUDED? The Settlement Class includes all residents of the United States whose payment card information was compromised as a result of the Security Incident. **Kimpton’s records show you are a likely member of the Settlement Class because you used your payment card at a Kimpton hotel or restaurant between February 16, 2016 and July 7, 2016.**

SETTLEMENT BENEFITS. The Settlement provides two types of payments to people who submit valid claims: 1) Reimbursement of up to \$250 for unreimbursed out-of-pocket expenses and documented lost time that resulted from the Security Incident; and 2) Reimbursement of up to \$10,000 for unreimbursed extraordinary expenses that were more likely than not caused by the Security Incident.

CLAIM FORM. To get a payment, you must file a Claim Form describing any expenses you incurred as a result of the Security Incident. To get a Claim Form, visit the website or call 1-855-789-0900. The claim deadline is **August 22, 2019**.

OTHER OPTIONS. If you do not want to be legally bound by the Settlement, you must exclude yourself by **June 8, 2019**. If you stay in the Settlement, you may object to it by **June 8, 2019**. The more detailed notice is available to explain how to exclude yourself or object. Please visit the website or call 1-855-789-0900 for a copy of the more detailed notice. On **June 20, 2019**, the Court will hold a hearing on whether to approve the Settlement, Class Counsel’s request for attorneys’ fees of up to \$800,000, inclusive of reasonable costs, and an incentive award of \$5,000 for the Representative Plaintiff. You or your own lawyer, if you have one, may ask to appear and speak at the hearing at your own cost, but you do not have to. For more information, call or visit the website below.
